GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB DRESS CODE

Appropriate golf attire is required for all players on the golf course as follows:

Blue denim or cotton sweat pants are not permitted on the golf course.

MEN:

- Collared shirts are required. Mock turtleneck shirts are acceptable. No t-shirts, tank tops or muscle shirts are allowed.
- Shorts are allowed and must be at least mid-thigh in length. No cut-offs or swimsuits.

LADIES:

- Collarless tops are permitted as well as sleeveless tops with a minimum 4" shoulder strap. No tank tops or half shirts allowed.
- Shorts must be at least mid-thigh in length. No cut-offs or swim suits allowed.

FOOTWEAR:

- Metal spiked shoes are not allowed. Approved golf shoes only, other sport shoes such as (football, soccer, track, etc.) are not allowed at any time.



Pine Mountain Lake Golf Course, has been rated **"4 ½ stars Best Places to Play"** by Golf Digest magazine. Designed by William F. Bell, and opened in 1970, PMLGC is open year-round and welcomes public and tournament play. Our 18-hole course offers pretty much everything a scratch golfer, high handicapper and everyone in between will appreciate; a classic mountain golf course, a fair and challenging layout with beautiful views, subtle greens and trees galore!

Our first tee sits at 2,800 feet, above the fog and below the snow! Summer daytime temps hover in the 80's to low 90's. Spring and Autumn bring perfect weather, low 70's to low 80's. And while it can get cold in the winter PML averages temps in the mid to low 50's. Occasionally we might get a light snow that allows us to enjoy the beauty without the bother and is usually gone within a day. During your round you'll enjoy all the flora and fauna the foothills have to offer: herds of mule deer, flocks of

blue jays and woodpeckers, ancient oaks and skyscraper-like pines, and the majestic peaks of Yosemite and the Sierra Nevada.

GOLF SHOP

The Golf Shop stocks a good variety of men's and ladies golf clothing including polos, tops, shorts, outerwear from Antigua, Bermuda Sands & Monterey Club and PML logoed headwear. We also offer balls from Titleist, Bridgestone and Callaway, shoes from FootJoy and Sketchers and clubs from Titleist, Cobra and TaylorMade.

The Golf Shop also offers rental clubs and push carts. Other services for PML Property Owners include golf bag storage, lockers and Golf Annuals. Inquire at the Golf Shop for more details.

DRIVING RANGE & PRACTICE AREAS

Our driving Range has both grass and artificial mats for warming up before your round or fine tuning

your swing. We also have a Short Game practice area with its own green and bunker for working on those scoring strokes. And don't forget to hit the Putting Green, adjacent to the 1st tee, before teeing off. Tokens for the range ball machine can be purchased at the Golf Shop or the Snack Shack; \$3 per token (25-30 balls) or 4 tokens for \$10 (over 100 balls).

TEE TIME RESERVATIONS

Reservations can be made by calling the Golf Shop at 209-962-8620 during regular Golf Shop hours (if we're not there please leave a message). Property Owners may reserve tee times up to 14 days in advance of play for themselves and their guests. Reservations for all days of Memorial Day, Independence Day and Labor Day holidays may be made 14 days prior to the first day of the

holiday weekend. All non-property owners can make reservations up to 10 days in advance of play. We accept reservations starting at 7 am March 14th through November 6th. Reservations during our "shotgun season" (11 am shotguns from November 7th – March 12th, 2017) can be made starting at 8 am.

Privileges

Additional identification may be required, property owner cards are nontransferable. No person(s) is permitted in the pool area without first registering with pool attendant. A limit on the number of persons in the pool at one time is enforced.

Age Requirement
