Appropriate golf attire is required for all players on the golf course as follows:

Blue denim or cotton sweat pants are not permitted on the golf course.

- Collared shirts are required. Mock turtleneck shirts are acceptable. No t-shirts, tank tops or muscle shirts are allowed.
- Shorts are allowed and must be at least mid-thigh in length. No cutoffs or swimsuits.

- Collarless tops are permitted as well as sleeveless tops with a minimum 4" shoulder strap. No tank tops or half shirts allowed.
- · Shorts must be at least midthigh in length. No cut-offs or swim suits allowed.

FOOTWEAR:

• Metal spiked shoes are not allowed. Approved golf shoes only, other sport shoes such as (football, soccer, track, etc.) are not allowed at any time.
