DEBRIS MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

You <u>MUST</u> initiate the process for tree removal, it is <u>NOT</u> automatic. *Here is where to start:*

- First, call PG&E at 1-800-743-5000.
- Press 4 for other.
- Press 4 for other and then say "tree trimming" as the reason for your call.
- You will need to speak to a representative, they will need to create a *Tree Work Notice Form* and will then give you a case #.

What you can expect once PG&E has received your *Tree Work Notice Form*

Step 1: An inspector will contact you to schedule a site interview at your property.

Step 2: an inspection will determine if your debris meets the criteria.

Step 3: You will be informed if you are qualified for the Debris Management Program.

Does your tree qualify for debris management?

See if it meets one or more of the criteria below:

- Wood is greater than 4 inches in diameter and 6 feet in length.
- Debris is within 100 feet of permanent structures. This does not include moveable or temporary sheds and outbuildings, or carports.
- Debris is within 20 feet of accessible roadways.
- Debris is reasonably accessible by equipment/machinery.

Due to past weather conditions and the amount of tree mortality, you may experience a delay in the process and removal of debris. All tree mortality related companies, services and technicians are extremely inundated so **please be patient.**
