Community Service Unit (CSU) Needs You!

As volunteers to the community, CSU assist the Sheriff's office with a variety of duties. These duties include a variety of activities that range from serving subpoenas, vacation checks, handicap parking enforcement, assisting motorists, transporting witnesses, assisting at crime scenes with security. CSU participates in annual community events throughout the county and your volunteer time might be requested.

There is an application process and as a CSU team member you would be asked to give approximately 16 hours per month and while the Sheriff's Office provides team gear, member safety gear, and much of the member's personal equipment, members provide their own apparel and often choose to buy their own personal equipment.

After joining the Team, you will be assigned a training officer and be provided with a "Skills Sign-Off Sheet" containing a list of basic skills needed for a chosen task. There are monthly meetings and monthly training classes in the evening. These are augmented by the annual training schedule to maintain necessary skills. This often requires a weekend per month training in the spring.

PG&E has cut your dead trees and you want them to remove the logs

Downed tree removal process

Call PG&E at 800-743-5000, press 4 for other, press 4 for other, say "tree trimming" as the reason for your call. Wait times can be long so be patient. They need to create a help ticket and they will give you a case # so you need to talk to a live person.

PG&E will send ACRT to inspect your Lot to see if it qualifies for the downed tree removal program. Needs to be within 100' of a structure (the neighbor's house qualifies) or within 20' of the street.

If you qualify you will receive an authorization form from ACRT for your signature and return to ACRT.

P & J is the subcontractor who will evaluate your Lot and remove the logs. There could be circumstances where P & J cannot remove your logs due to location, ground condition or other extenuating circumstances but this should be the exception.
