

On Saturday, April 21 representatives of Tuolumne County including Supervisor John Gray, County Administrator Craig Pedro and Assistant County Administrator Tracie Riggs addressed the Pine Mountain Lake Association Board of Directors meeting regarding the impact of the devastating storm of March 22 on the County's infrastructure. Particular attention was paid to the extensive damage to Ferretti Road that resulted in its closure and detour through PMLA.

During the presentation specific information was shown detailing the impacts on the County's road system and the necessary recovery efforts. While the County representatives stated that Ferretti Road is the highest priority road repair in the County, Federal funding will be needed. The recent emergency proclamation by Governor Brown will now allow the County to apply for this funding. Unfortunately, this will take time.
