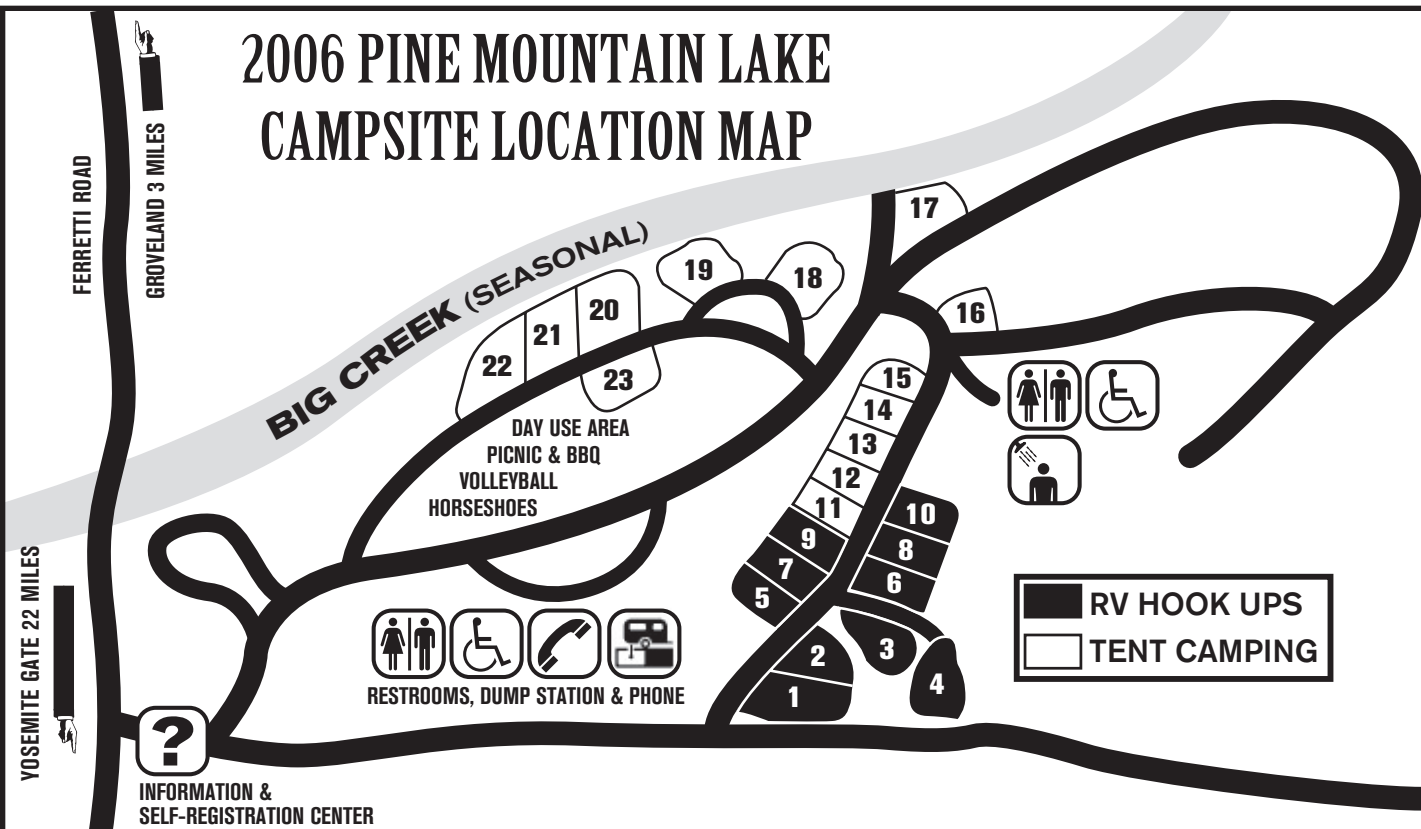

2006 PINE MOUNTAIN LAKE CAMPSITE LOCATION MAP



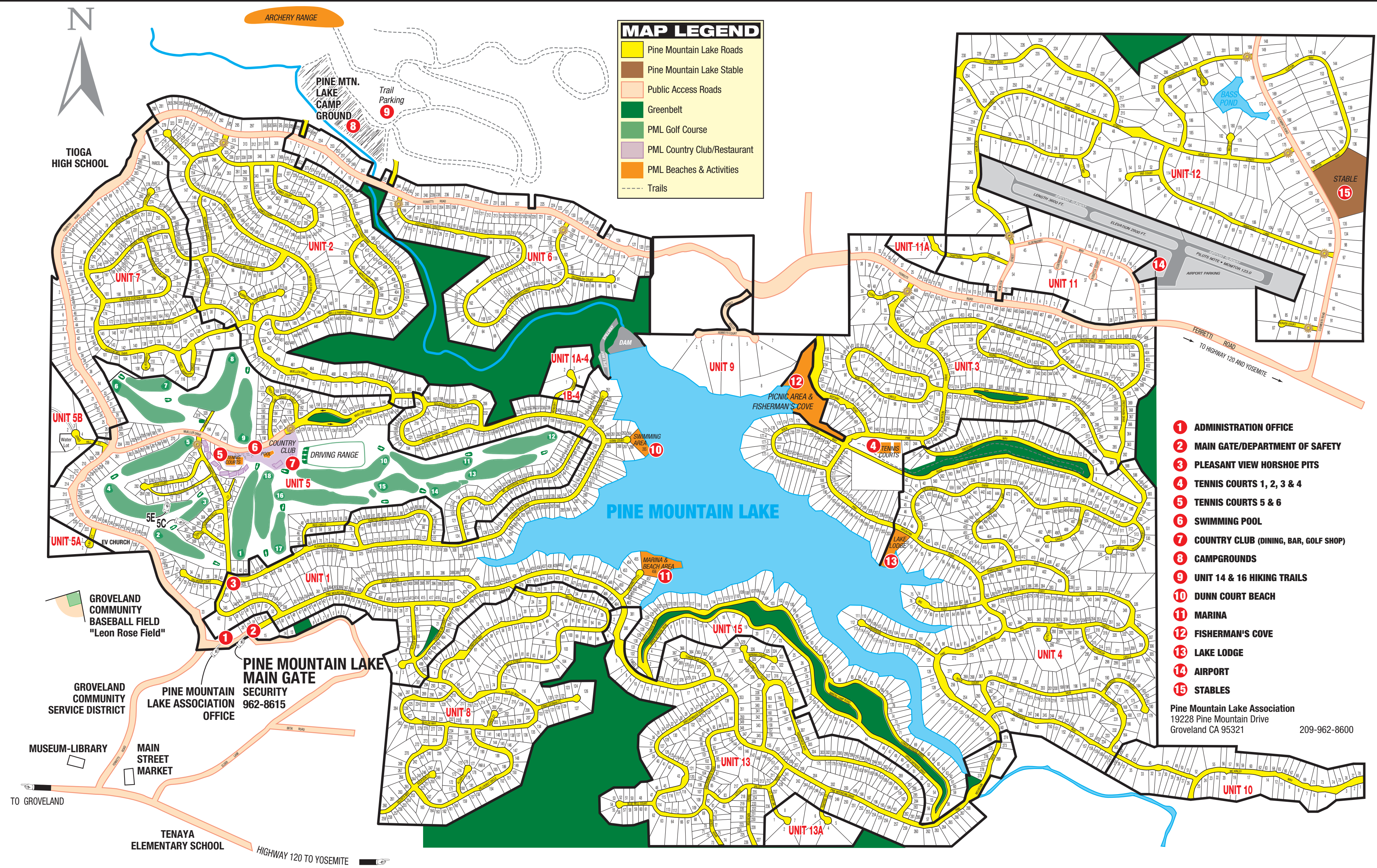

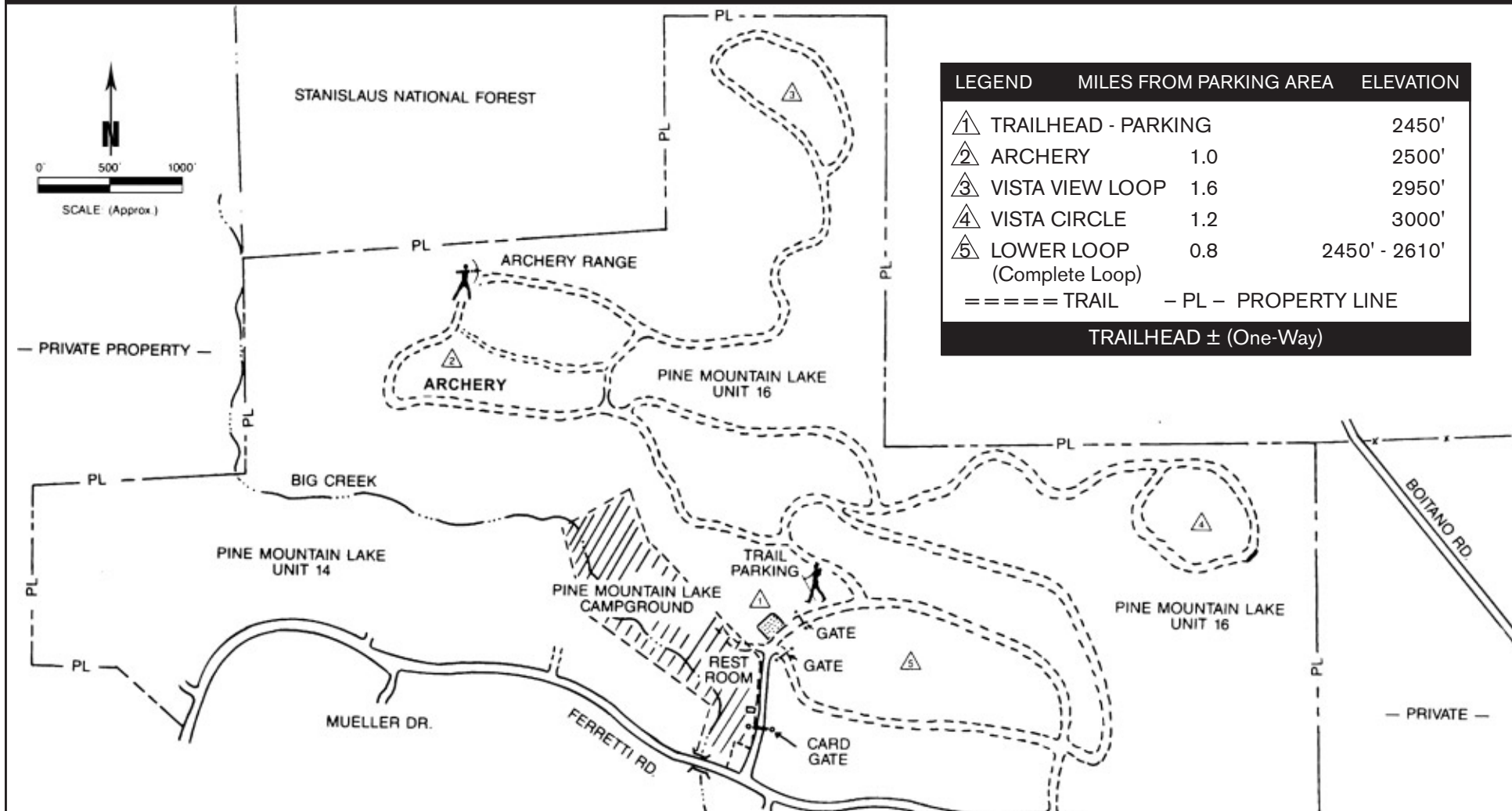

HIKING TRAILS AND ARCHERY RANGE MAP



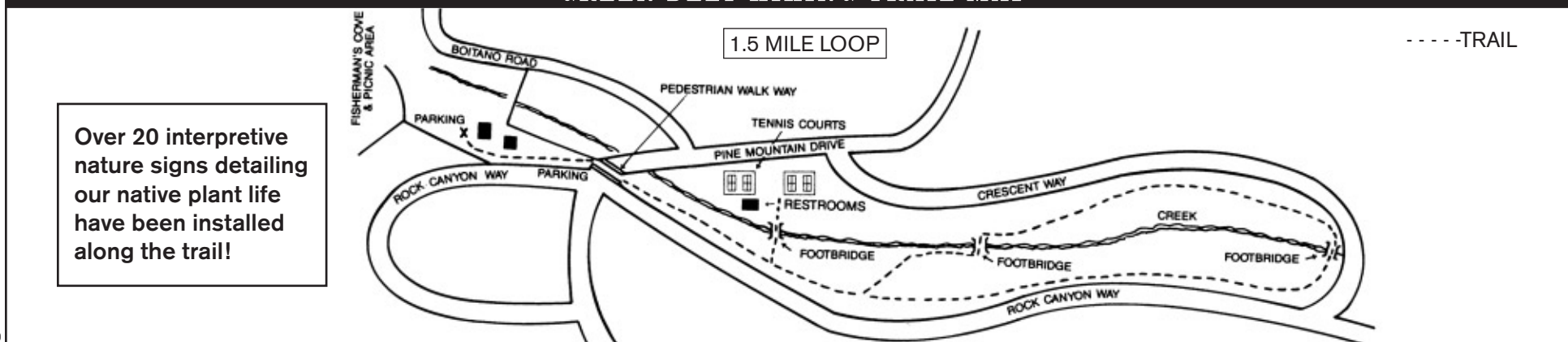

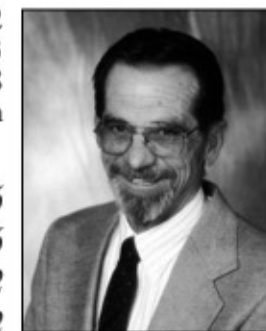
