RE-OPENING PROCEDURES

Tuolumne County Health Department and California State Covid-19 physical distancing and health restrictions apply.

- If you are feeling ill, do not visit the campground until you have recovered.
- Advanced reservations required.
 - Reservations can be made by contacting The Department of Safety at (209) 962-8615.
 - No Drop-In's
- Only one household per campsite
- No group gatherings
- All RV's must be self-contained- Functioning toilets, showers, holding tanks for black and grey water.
 - Campground restrooms are closed at this time
- Campers must utilize their own alcohol based hand-sanitizer, masks and gloves and disinfectants
- Campers are responsible for disinfecting the picnic table and BBQ.
- Dump Station is available by appointment only - call (209) 962-8615
 - Camper must remain in vehicle until the dump is opened
 - Camper must utilize their own gloves, mask and hand sanitizer while using the dump station
 - Camper will perform all dumping duties and pack out any trash used at the dump station
- Tent sites remain temporarily closed
- Volleyball, tetherball and horseshoe pit remains temporarily closed
