DUNN COURT AND LAKE LODGE BEACH & LAWN AREAS RE-OPENING WED JUNE 24TH

The Association is reopening the Dunn Court and Lake Lodge beach and lawn area to property owners, special users, long-term renters and short-term renters. Tuolumne County Health Department and California State COVID-19 physical distancing and health restrictions apply.

RE-OPENING PROCEDURES

- If you are feeling ill, do not visit the beach or lawn areas until you have recovered.
- A maximum of 20 families may use the beach at one time.
- Do not block traffic on cross roads. An emergency vehicle must be able to safely drive through at any given moment.
- Every other parking spot will be coned off to reduce the number of people that can go onto the beach or lawn area.
- The entrance and each cone will have a sign on it stating "NO PARKING, if this cone is moved to park, then a parking citation will be issued to the vehicle in this space."
- If a cone is moved, then the Department of Safety will issue a parking citation.
- Use picnic table at your own risk. You are responsible for the disinfection of its surface upon arrival and exit.
- Individuals must remain a minimum of six feet apart.
- Individuals will not share toys, floaties, towels, food etc.
- Boat Patrol will check the beach each hour and reinforced social distancing protocol as needed.
- If noncompliance is a trend, the beach will be closed.
- Soap and water are available at the existing restrooms and multiple hand washing stations.
- Individuals may utilize self-provided alcohol based hand-sanitizer.
- Individuals may bring a self-contained water bottle. No refills.
- Vending machines are disabled.
- No event shall be hosted at this time.
