



PML GOLF COURSE RESTRICTED RE-OPENING PROCEDURES

On behalf of the entire Staff and Management at Pine Mountain Lake Golf & Country Club, we would like to give you an update on our policies concerning the golf course. Beginning June 17, the Golf Course will be open to all players. We will still have in place the required operational changes, sanitary practices and strict physical distancing protocols. Below is a complete list of policies and procedures that will help protect our Members and Staff from the potential exposure to the COVID-19 virus.

TEE TIME RESERVATIONS

The golf course will be open to **to ALL PLAYERS**. • All golfers will be required to have a pre-arranged tee time in order to play golf on the course, no walk-up play will be allowed. • The golf shop will accept phone calls at **(962-8620)** for tee time reservations. **The first tee time will be 8:00 am daily**. • Normal tee time reservation policies will be in effect; Property Owners can make reservations up to 14 days in advance and public players can make reservations 10 days in advance. • Intervals between tee times will be **14 minutes**.

GENERAL INFORMATION

If you are feeling ill, **DO NOT** come to the golf course until you have recovered. • The state and county require us to enforce strict physical distancing protocols on the golf course and around the cart staging areas (**a minimum of 6 foot spacing between individuals**). • Sanitizing wipes and or liquid will be available around the facility. • Commonly touched surfaces will be sanitized by our staff on a regular basis. • Golfers are encouraged to wash and or sanitize their hands on a regular basis. Organized groups of golfers must not gather before or after their round of golf. • All drinking fountains and the ice machine have been covered and are not available for use. Please bring your own ice and water with you to the course. • Rental clubs and push carts will not be available, each golfer must bring their own equipment.

REGISTRATION

Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes before your scheduled tee time. • When approaching the registration area, there will be directional signs for you to follow. Payments can be made by credit card or member charge only, cash will not be accepted at this time. • Entry into the golf shop will not be available at this time, transactions will be made through the side window of the golf shop. • We will have 1 cart rental agreement per person for individuals to sign instead of the 1 sheet we normally use for multiple signatures. Annual members and punch card holders do not need to sign for their cart as they have already signed an agreement at the time of purchase. • The golf shop and outside staff will wash and or sanitize their hands on a regular basis. • Golf balls will be the only merchandise available for purchase at this time. • Tees and ball markers will be available upon request at no charge.

LOCKER ROOMS

If you need to access your locker, you will be allowed to enter the locker room once before your tee time but due to physical distancing protocols, **only 2 people will be allowed into the locker room at a time**. • Please take the items you removed from your locker home with you as access to the locker rooms will be greatly restricted as a result of the physical distancing protocols.

RESTROOMS

Entry into the restrooms will be available but with the **2 person maximum** policy in effect.

BAG/PUSH CART STORAGE

If you store your bag or push cart we will bring your bag or push cart out and position it accordingly, the first time you play. After the completion of your round you will need to take your bag and or push cart with you and keep them with you until further notice.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Our practice facilities will be **open with strict "Physical Distancing Protocols" required**. • Practice Putting Green: **Maximum of 6 people**. Short Game Area: **Maximum of 2 people**. Driving Range: **Maximum of 10 people**. • Signage will be posted at all practice facilities with specific information concerning each area.

GOLF CARTS

Single rider carts will be available for each player at no extra charge. Members of the same household may ride together in the same cart. Please keep the carts on the cart paths as much as possible. • Carts will be sanitized before each round, including the steering wheel, seats, seat rail, cup holders, bag clips and straps, key, glove box, windshield and dash board. • Scorecards and pencils have been removed from the carts and will be available by request only. • Mulch bottles have been removed from the carts, **SO PLEASE REPLACE YOUR DIVOTS**. • After you round, please remove all your items from the cart; trash, clubs, balls, tees, cell phones, any and all items you have used during the round.

GOLF COURSE

All play must start off the first tee, no shotgun starts will be allowed until further notice. • Bunker rakes have been removed, as a result, play lift, clean and place within one club length, no nearer to the hole in the bunkers. • Ball washers and drinking fountains are covered and are not available for use. • A spacer has been placed in the cup 1 inch below the surface so balls will go into the hole but will not go completely into the bottom of the hole, making it easy to retrieve the ball without touching the hole or flagstick. • On course restrooms will be sanitized in the morning and periodically during the day. Sanitizing solution will be available for customer use at the on course restrooms.

FOOD & BEVERAGE

The Snack Shack will be open from 9:30 am to 3:00 pm daily. • The Grill will be open for TAKE OUT lunch Wednesday thru Sunday 11:00 am to 4:00 pm and dine-in dinner Wednesday thru Sunday 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm, RESERVATIONS REQUIRED, call **962-8638**.

SCORE POSTING

The NCGA score posting computer is not available for use at this time. Golfers can post their scores on line from their personal device.
