PORTABLE OUTDOOR FIREPLACE

A portable, outdoor, solid-fuel-burning fireplace that may be constructed of steel, concrete, clay or other noncombustible material. A portable outdoor fireplace may be open in design, or may be equipped with a small hearth opening and a short chimney or chimney opening in the top.

JUNE 1 – NOVEMBER 15: Burning and any type of open fire is **suspended. No burning of combustible material of any kind is allowed.** The one exception is fire produced by propane gas (BBQ or fire pit).

NOVEMBER 16 – MAY 31: All portable outdoor fireplaces must obtain a PMLA burn permit (which must be in your possession) and follow the outlined guidelines.

- Portable outdoor fireplaces shall be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and shall not be operated within 15 feet of a structure or combustible material. (2016 CFC 307.4.3)
- Contact the Main Gate at (209) 962-8615 to:
 - ✓ report your intent to burn,
 - ✓ provide your PMLA permit number,
 - ✓ provide your unit/lot
 - ✓ confirm if it is a permissible burn day
- Clear all flammable material and within 10-feet and do not place under low hanging branches
- A garden hose connected to a water supply or other approved fire-extinguishing equipment shall be readily available.
- An adult must be present at all times, capable of using fire-extinguishing equipment and is familiar with the permit conditions.
- The burning material shall be attended until it has been extinguished, No burning shall be undertaken unless weather conditions (particularly wind) are such that burning can be considered safe.
- Wait for all the ashes to cool before disposing of them, or else douse them with plenty of water first.
