

A Guide to Your Vacation in Pine Mountain Lake Association



Rules to Follow for an Enjoyable Stay:

- Quiet hours are 10pm 7am
- Dogs must be leashed at all times, and are not allowed at any of the beaches
- Garbage must only be placed curbside on the day of pick up
- No parking is allowed on the streets
- Parking in the parking lot at the marina is restricted to property owners only on weekends and holidays
- Please obey all posted speed limits & traffic signs
- No trespassing on private property
- Pine Mountain Lake has strict rules for burning. Only propane fire pits and barbecues are permitted. Call 209-962-8615 for current burn restrictions.
- No fireworks permitted in Tuolumne County
- Only property owners are permitted to launch water-craft on Pine Mountain Lake. Please contact our Marina Store for details regarding boat rentals

Be Prepared in an Emergency

When staying in our beautiful community, it is important to know where your exits are, should a natural disaster or hazard occur, that may require an evacuation. It is everyone's responsibility to be prepared. We highly encourage you to familiarize yourself with Pine Mountain Lake and be aware of your exit locations. You may exit out of any gate; however, you may only enter through the main entrance gate (where you received your pass upon arrival). We encourage you to purchase a map of the community to acquaint yourself with gate locations in order to know where you would exit if you and your family need to evacuate.
