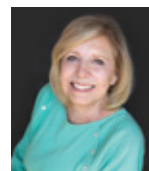

Pine Mountain Lake Golf Course is the Hidden Jewel of the Foothills!

Our 18-hole semi-private golf course, voted "4 1/2 Stars Best Places to Play" by Golf Digest Magazine, offers beautiful views on a classic mountain style course designed by William F. Bell, and opened in 1970. Our 2800 foot elevation allows year-round play and we are "Above the Fog and Below the Snow". The

course winds through ancient oaks, towering pines and fragrant cedars, down valleys and across hills with beautiful views of the snow-capped Sierra Nevada mountains.

Each hole has its own challenges and with four sets of tees, you can change your experience just by changing which tees you play from. The greens are subtle and staying below the hole is always a good idea as downhillers can be tricky.

No matter your skill level you'll find your day spent on the course quite enjoyable with all of the flora and fauna that the foothills have to offer: herds of mule deer, red-tail hawks, blue jays and wildlife galore!

Tee Time Reservations

PML Property Owners may make reservations up to 14 days in advance by calling the Golf Shop at 1-209-962-8620. All others may call 10 days in advance. Reservations for all days of summer's major holidays – Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day – can be made two weeks prior to the first day of the holiday weekend. We accept reservations starting at 7am. "Winter Season" starts the day after daylight saving time ends and continues until daylight saving time begins and reservations are accepted starting at 8am.

Driving Range & Practice Areas

Our driving Range has both grass and artificial mats for warming up before your round or fine tuning your swing. We also have a Short Game practice area with its own green and bunker for working on those scoring strokes. And don't forget to hit the Putting Green, adjacent to the 1st tee, before teeing off. Tokens for the range ball machine can be purchased at the Golf Shop or the Snack Shack; \$4 per token (26 balls) or 4 tokens for \$13 (over 100 balls).

GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB DRESS CODE

Appropriate golf attire is required for all users of the golf course as follows:

Blue denim or cotton sweat pants are not permitted on the golf course.

MEN: Collared shirts are required.

Mock turtleneck shirts are acceptable. No t-shirts, tank tops or muscle shirts are allowed.

Shorts are allowed and must be at least mid-thigh in length.

No cut-offs or swimsuits.

LADIES: Collarless tops are permitted as well as sleeveless tops with a minimum 4" shoulder strap. No tank tops or half shirts allowed. • Shorts must be at least mid-thigh in length. No cut-offs or swim suits allowed.

FOOTWEAR: Metal spiked shoes are not allowed. Approved golf shoes only, other sport shoes such as (football, soccer, track, etc.) are not allowed at any time.

The Pine Mountain Lake Pool is a family recreation center with many different activities: ping pong, board games, cards, books and magazines, water toys and more are all available from the pool attendants. For your convenience, the pool also has a snack bar. The snack bar is open during all pool hours. Enjoy our quality snacks and ice cream at very competitive prices.

PRIVILEGES

There is no charge to use the pool. Guests must be accompanied by a property owner or have a valid guest pass. No admittance without property owner card or valid guest pass. Add'l identification may be required, property owner cards are nontransferable. No person(s) permitted in the pool area without first registering with pool attendant. A limit on the number of persons in the pool at one time is enforced (max of 63 people in pool at one time).

AGE REQUIREMENT

Children under 14 must be accompanied and monitored by an adult at least eighteen (18) years of age.

INFANTS & TODDLERS

Children not potty-trained must wear plastic pants or approved swim diapers with a plastic pant over it — "double-bagged". Please bring your own or purchase them at the pool store.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES AT THE POOL

Pool Socials: Fun family entertainment,

including music & BBQ one Saturday a month in July and August from 6 pm to 8 pm. Come out and meet the staff! Check with the pool staff for party information as the dates approach. See Pool Attendant on duty for ping pong balls & paddles.

WATER AEROBICS CLASSES

Seven (7) days a week thru October 31.

Open to all property owners. No charge to participate. Enjoy aqua exercise classes (instructed by selected audio tapes) for all fitness levels. Each class consists of a series of aquatic exercises, performed in the pool using water as resistance. Simply perform exercises for a safe and effective means of achieving overall body and cardiovascular conditioning.

From tournament players to beginners, everyone is welcome. We may have a loaner tennis racquet for you. Get your pass at the main gate at Pine Mountain Lake and come on out to join us!

Court Locations and Times

Pine Mountain Lake Association (PMLA) has four courts located at Rock Canyon Way and Pine Mountain Drive. Courts 3 & 4 have lights until 10:00 PM, suitable for night play. The lights go out automatically at 10:00 PM and cannot be turned back on.

GENERAL RULES

A valid tennis pass is required to play. Annual tennis passes are sold at the Association Office. The Summer Pass runs Memorial Day thru Labor Day also sold at the Association office. Daily and monthly passes are sold at the Main Gate Department of Safety. Non-marking tennis shoes only. Appropriate tennis attire, no food or drink other than water on the courts. No glass containers. No pets on the courts.

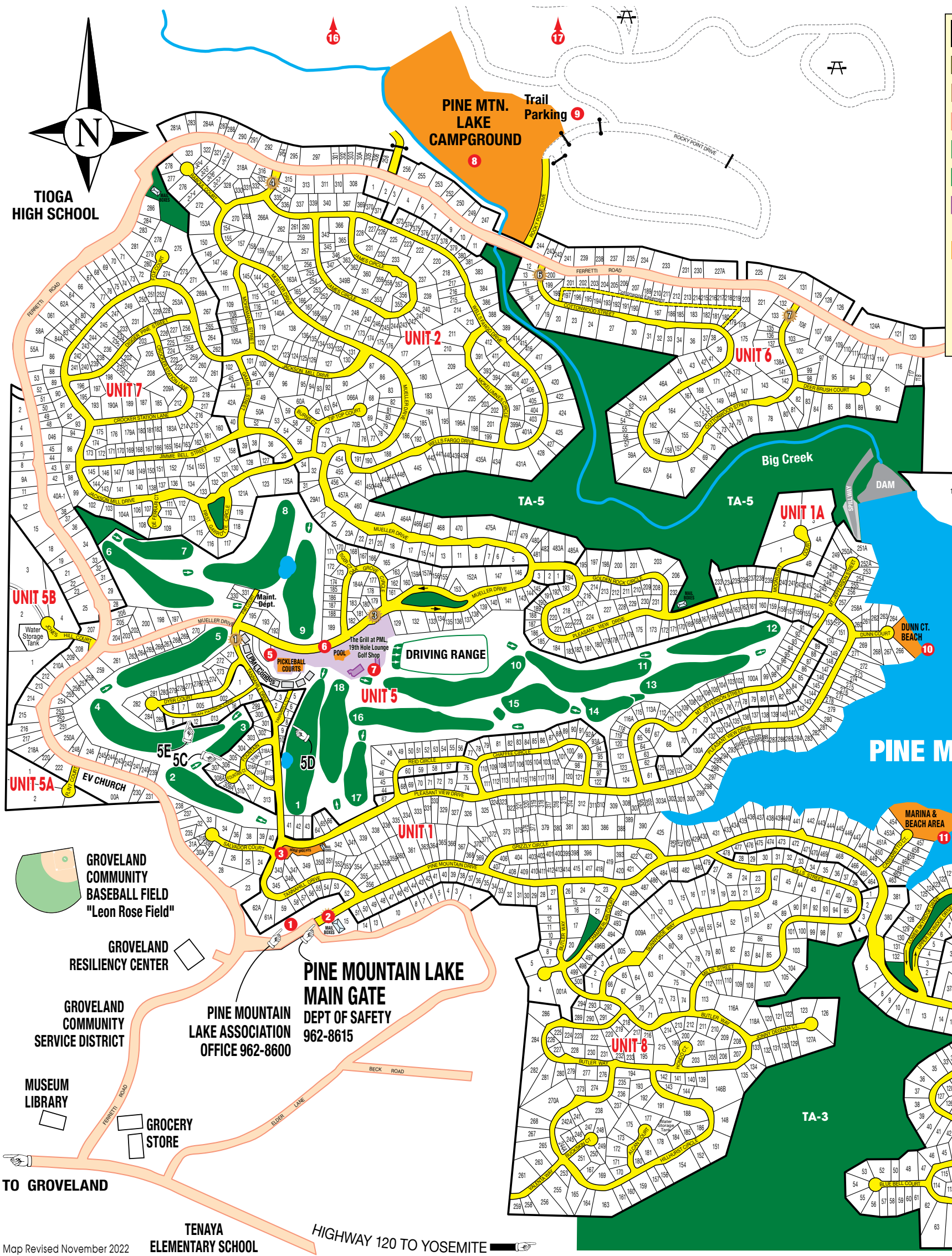

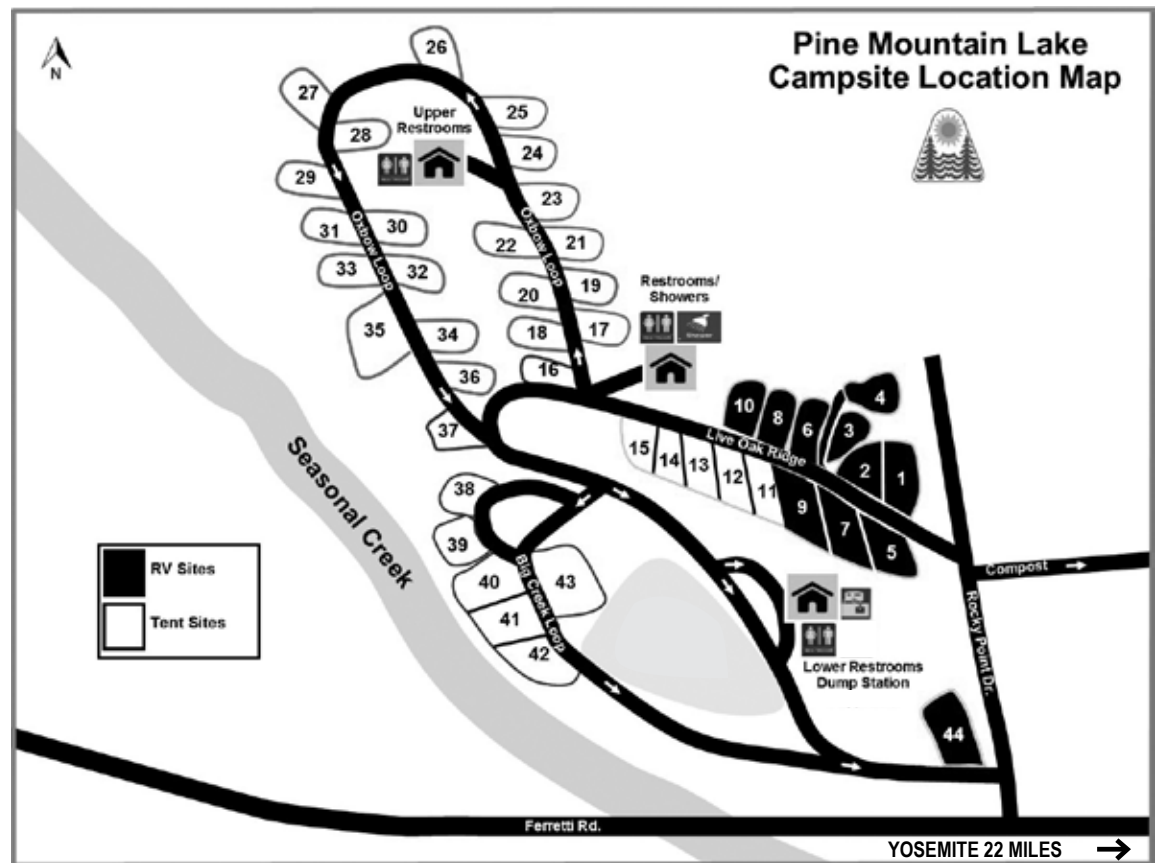

Our facilities include 33 campsites, each with stand barbecues and a picnic table and 11 RV hook-up sites, each with power and water (dump site on location). Our guests have the use of 3 nearby restrooms, both with running water, one with hot showers. Bathrooms require codes which can be requested through the main gate. Enjoy the hiking trails.

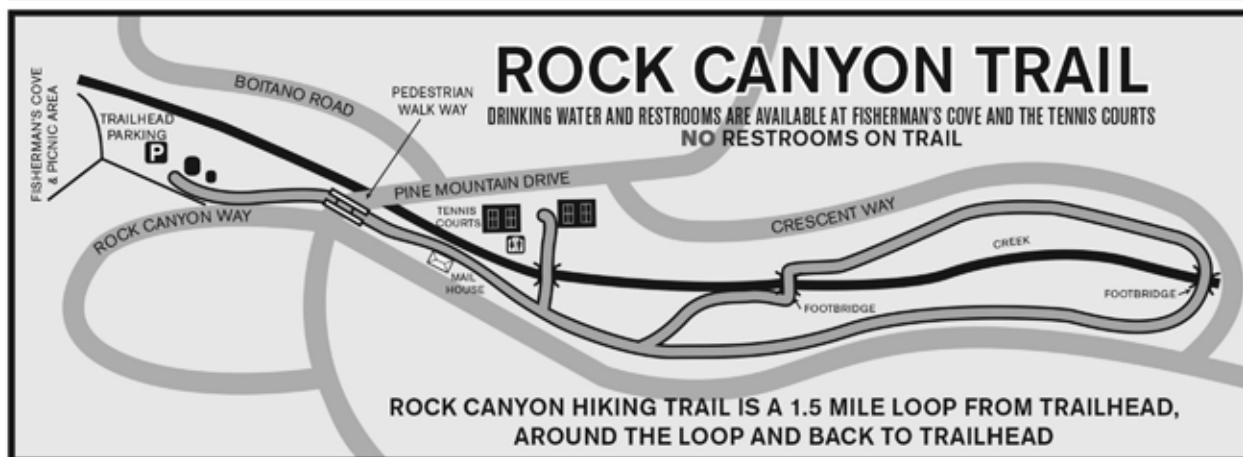
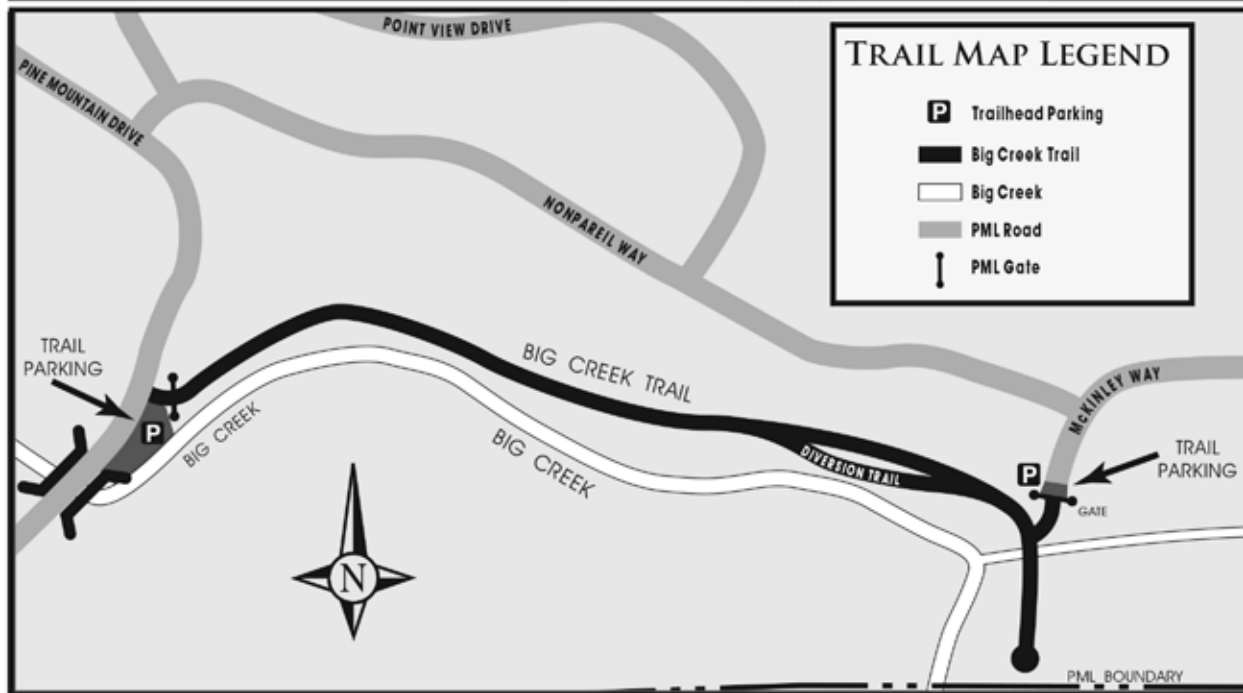
